Specifications and Instructions for Installation

Your new Krystal Writing Board comes in many different custom sizes, shapes and configurations. All boards are created using the highest standards and quality materials. Whether you purchase one of our Glass or Laminated products be confident that you are getting the best industry standards in manufacturing and safety protocols. Special coatings are incorporated and baked into the glass to make sure you receive a product that will support ongoing visibility and durability for the limitless life of your board.

If you purchased the standard Krystal Writing Board, no matter what option (Clear, Frosted or Coated) you will see holes measuring 1.375 inches placed appropriately to hang your board. You will also be supplied with Fixtures made up of a round base piece with a female adapter and a .1875-inch hole in the center, 2 high-grade rubber washers, 1 high-grade plastic bushing, and a round cap with a male adapter. (See images below). The fixtures are extremely substantial pieces made of steel and powder coated with the desired finish.



Fixtures are attached to the wall by installing an anchor* at the desired location, placing the female portion over it and screwing into the anchor. Then place the bushing and one washer on the extrusion. Once all fixtures are attached, place the last washer over the male portion and screw in the top. Important note – Do NOT over tighten the fixture or you run the risk of locking the two metal elements together. Simply apply enough force for a secure fit. (If placing an Acrylic Holder on any fixture insert over female portion before last washer and top piece is attached)

* While we supply some standard anchors and screws that most clients use for installation, there are too many variables for us to specifically indicate what would be best for your installation needs. Also, some clients have felt the need to modify these instructions due to wall conditions, the size of the board they ordered and / or any design elements that they wished to incorporate.
